Abstract	Limited to 30 lines (standard SF 424 guidelines)

Biosketches	Limited to 2 pages including <i>all</i> sections (<i>maximum</i> 10 publications)
Research Plan	Standard font and margin requirements Omit Introduction, Background and Significance, and Preliminary Studies sections Specific Aims <i>limited</i> to 1 page Research Design <i>limited</i> to 12 pages (new sections listed below) <i>Include the following sections with appropriate headings</i> *Research Area *Opportunity and Potential Impact *Approach (do not include a detailed experimental plan) *Timeline, Milestones, Expected Measurable Outcomes and Deliverables *Long Term Sustainability Plan <i>A detailed statement addressing the following justifications must be included in the Research Plan:</i> <i>-The work cannot be reasonably expected to be carried out without "Go" Support</i> <i>-Specific outcomes will advance the mission of the NIH to improve health</i> <i>-The project will be deployed immediately upon funding</i> <i>-Funding will accelerate current and future research and there are measurable outcomes to evaluate the short/long term effects of the project</i> <i>-Project may not be carried out by any other entity and there are benefits to having the results be in the public domain</i> <i>-Project generated results/resources may be integrated with other NIH research</i> <i>-Additional funding necessary beyond this timeframe to maintain the project must be justified with a plan for additional funding obtained from sources other than NIH</i>

Items to Keep in Mind if awarded	90 day pre-award costs are allowable Requires quarterly reporting Requires tracking the number of positions created and retained Award will affect eligibility of PIs for future mentored career awards (K08/K23) No supplemental funds or NCE requests are allowable
